

Andres can be seen and heard just about everywhere in LA, he has performed and recorded with artists such as: Deadmau5, That Dog, Queens of the Stone Age, Weird Al Yankovich, Halsey and H. After leaving the east coast, Andres studied at San Francisco Conservatory of Music to study with Jeff Anderson of the San Francisco Symphony.
